<u>Consultation Summary: Malvern Hills National Landscape Guidance on</u> <u>Horse-Related Development</u>

PLEASE NOTE: On 22 November 2023, the Malvern Hills Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty (AONB), was rebranded as the Malvern Hills National Landscape. National Landscapes are designated AONBs. For the purposes of this consultation summary, reference is made to the Malvern Hills AONB Unit when work was undertaken prior to re-branding, and the Malvern Hills National Landscape Team for work following re-branding.

Purpose of this summary

This note details the steps taken by the Malvern Hills National Landscape Team to consult others on an updated guidance document relating to Horse-Related Development within the Malvern Hills National Landscape. The guidance stems from the 'Keeping Horses in the Landscape' Guidance which was previously published by the Malvern Hills AONB Partnership.

Pre-Consultation

A draft guidance document was compiled by staff within the Malvern Hills AONB Unit during early 2023. Prior to this (August 2022) an earlier draft was circulated to horse owners for their initial comments, which helped to shape the final draft document.

Consultation

This guidance document was consulted on at the same time as the following draft documents: Position Statement 2: Housing Development in the Malvern Hills National Landscape and its Setting, Position Statement 3: Landscape-led Development, and updated Guidance on Lighting.

The consultation draft was available to view on the Malvern Hills AONB website (https://www.malvernhills-nl.org.uk/consultations/) between 8 June and 4 August 2023. Visitors were encouraged to download the draft guidance and to submit comments via a downloadable comment form and return accordingly to the AONB Unit Planning Officer (shared).
